SWAMP DARNER OVIPOSITING IN JUNE

Here's a photo of an *Epiaeschna heros* (Swamp Darner) that Islay Cowie (and Kerr) observed ovipositing on 9-June-2013 on a log in the frog pond at Inniswoods Metro Gardens in Columbus, Ohio. There wasn't much water near the log at the time. That's a pretty shallow pond that can be dry in late summer.

They were reading the Ohio Dragon-Flier (Volume 24(1) 2014) and saw that swamp darners (as reported in the article by Andrew Boose (*Dragonflier Volume 24(1) Pages* 3-4) in central Ohio generally oviposit in late April and that they had a record of one ovipositing in late May in 2010.

So, here's a later date to add to the data. Nice Job Islay!!

SMALL GRANTS FROM OOS? By the OOS Officers

Editors note: to date we have not been able to give away any \$\$... why - noone has applied! You have a few weeks yet until the deadline for this \$\$ - apply this year!

Attached to the email including this Dragonflier newsletter was a fillable form that members can use to apply for the OOS Small Grant for 2014-2015.

Below is re-printed / updated from the dragonflier Volume 21#2, 2011

This is the call for proposals that is open to current OOS members in good standing (i.e. paid for the year proposal is submitted (2014) & potentially funded). The recipient, or recipients, of the small grant (if any) will be expected to present their findings, or project overview and results, to that point at the annual OOS meeting the following year. (i.e. projects receiving a small grant in 2014 must present at the 2015 annual meeting).

Small grant proposals up to a maximum of \$500.00 will be evaluated and considered. The OOS officers serving at the time of the proposal submission will form the committee to evaluate, accept and potentially fund the proposal (or proposals). Duration of the small grants program will be limited by the amount in treasury that exceeds anticipated operating funds and will be suspended upon depletion of the OOS funds available. Application form and details, deadlines and evaluation procedures are in the attached application form. If you have trouble with this document please contact newsletter editor Steve Chordas III (stevechordas@sbcglobal.net) or contact Steve by phone at 614-421-7159 and we will get a form to you. Also see the motion for the small grants in the meeting minutes on page 4 of the 2011 Dragonflier (Volume 21 Number 2, 2011).

Submit your winning proposal now (completed proposals are to be submitted to the OOS President: *Andrew Boose* (boose@metroparks.net). Proposal submissions will be officially be accepted until 11:59pm on 10-June-2014. Announcement of the winning proposal (if any or proposals if more than one) will occur at the next annual meeting (21-June-2014). Best of luck!

Dragon reports are trickling in and a few surprises have been noted. Painted Skimmers (Libellula semifasciata) have been prevalent at North Chagrin Reservation (T. Eiben) and in Geauga County (m.obs). Linda Gilbert found Southern Pygmy Clubtails (Lanthus vernalis) emerging at the West Woods. Becky Donaldson found Red Saddlebags (Tramea onusta) at Kelleys Island on May 3 while enjoying views of a Kirtland's Warbler.

Judy and Larry were fortunate to have a CMNH trip to Lake Katherine area in Jackson County the weekend of 17-18 May. Weather was not conducive for dragons for the most part, but when the sun did shine we managed to locate a couple of adult male Blue Corporals (Ladona deplanata). Rick Gardner and Dave Minney took us to the Pike County area that hosts Yellow-sided Skimmers (Libellula flavida) and Rick found a youngster that had just hatched out. We did not get photos of the Corporal so if any one gets to Lake Katherine in the next few days, keep an eye out and get us a valid photograph to document its occurrence in Jackson County.


